Starting in 2007, the Pleasanton Community Improvement Committee began working with the Village of Pleasanton and the Earl Klein family to develop the Pleasanton community entryway. A new park has begun to develop, in the name of the former land owner, Rosalia Klein. The park will be called "Klein Park". The park sits at the corner of Sycamore and Elm Street in Pleasanton, Nebraska (across the street, east from Town & Country Bank)

Klein Park will be the home for many flowers, trees and grassy areas for families to enjoy a nice spring or summer day. A sidewalk will surround the park with a nice white picket fence, to ensure the safety of many children who are sure to enjoy the park. The planning committee pictures a large blue spruce tree on the east side of the park, to be decorated during the Holidays and to welcome many visitors to our fine community. The park will host benches and a gazebo to entice local families and Highway 10 travelers to stop to enjoy a nice spring or summer day with a malt from the nearby Riverstop. Picture fun games in the park during the annual Old Setter Celebrations or a family picnic, or be a destination for many walkers in the community to get in their daily walk.

Fall 2008, a new sidewalk around the park has been poured by community volunteers. Spring 2009, will be a busy time installing underground sprinklers and preparing the soil for landscaping. The Committee is hopeful to host a Spring or Fall Garden Party to help raise the final dollars needed to finalize the park. A total of \$20,000 will need to be raised through the "Prime Real Estate Brick Sale" and the Garden Party to complete the park. Currently 10% of the goal has been raised by community donations and a grant from the Pleasanton Community Foundation.

Bricks will run along the walkways, around benches and the gazebo to show your support to the many visitors. Your bricks can promote your family name or a gift in the name of a loved one.
